

FINANCIAL STATEMENT FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International applicants requesting immigration documents from IUP must submit a financial statement that shows their best estimate of funding sources to support their studies and cost of living. Once a student is admitted, the Office of International Education will work with students to confirm their funding sources (scholarships, loans, assistantships) and request more documentation prior to issuing an I-20. IUP does not offer full scholarships.
