1. An exact statement of what is to be deleted.

The course listing for ENVH 323 Introduction to Toxicology and Risk Assessment is to be deleted.

2. Justification/Rationale

The B.S. in Environmental Health Science is being revised to a B.S. in Biology / Environmental Health Track. All ENVH course listings are no longer needed and will be deleted as part of this program revision. ENVH 323 Introduction to Toxicology and Risk Assessment is cross-listed as BIOL 323 Introduction to Toxicology and Risk Assessment which will be retained.

3. ENVH 323 is currently a required core course for a B.S. in Environmental Health Science. Students currently enrolled in this program can take BIOL 323 in lieu of ENVH 323.
